- The Licensing Committee met January 9 to hear from stakeholders regarding SB 159, which authorizes pharmacists to furnish preexposure and postexposure prophylaxis for HIV.
- The CPJE was administered January 18. Results were released the last week of January. The Board also announced remaining <u>CPJE test dates for 2020</u>.
- The Board held a quarterly two-day meeting January 29-30 in Glendale. The agenda, materials and action items are posted on the <u>Board Meetings</u> page.
- The Board appointed Anne Sodergren as Executive Officer.
