Routine Release of Examination Results

The California State Board of Pharmacy (board) will only provide examination results by mail to the candidate's address of record on file with the board.

The board releases the California Practice Standards and Jurisprudence Examination for Pharmacists (CPJE) results only after validating that results are psychometrically sound pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 139. If you have not received your results after 90 days from taking the exam, please email the board to request a status by identifying your file number listed on your eligibility letter, your full name, and date of your CPJE at intern-examstatus@dca.ca.gov.

The board typically releases the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) for the North American Pharmacist Licensure Examination (NAPLEX) within 30-45 days of examination administration in coordination with the NABP and will release them earlier when possible. If it has been over 45 days since you sat for the NAPLEX, requested a score or license transfer, please email the board to request a status by identifying your file number listed on your eligibility letter, your full name, and date of your NAPLEX as well indicating if you requested a score or license transfer at intern-examstatus@dca.ca.gov.
