19	1. Anne Sodergren (Complainant) brings this Statement of Issues solely in her official	
20	capacity as the Executive Officer of the Board of Pharmacy(Board), Department of Consumer	
21	Affairs.	
22	2. On or about November 13, 2020, the Board received an application for a Pharmacist	
23	License from Respondent. On or about November 10, 2020, Respondent certified under penalty	
24	of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the application.	
25	The Board denied the application on March 9, 2021.	
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## **Previous Licenses**

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- 3. On or about March 6, 1990, the Board issued Pharmacist License Number RPH 43129 to Lan Thi Tran Nguyen (Respondent). On or about August 21, 2013, the Pharmacist License was surrendered and revoked.
- 4. On or about March 24, 2008, the Board issued Pharmacy Permit No. PHY 49001 to Respondent to do business as Du Pharmacy (Du Pharmacy). The Pharmacy Permit was surrendered and revoked effective August 21, 2013.

## PRIOR DISCIPLINE

5. On or about October 29, 2010, a disciplinary action was filed against Respondent and Du Pharmacy entitled In the Matter of the Accusation Against: Lan Thi Tran Nguyen, Pharmacist License No. RPH 43129, Du Pharmacy, Permit No. PHY 49001. The accusation alleged Respondent violated various sections of the Business and Professions Code, Health and Safety Code, California Code of Regulations, title 16, and United States Code, title 21. Effective August 21, 2013, pursuant to a Stipulated Decision and Order (Order) entitled Stipulated Surrender and Revocation of Licenses and Order, Board Case No. 3727, OAH No. 2010110837, Also Pertaining to Citation No. CI 2010 48444, OAH No. 2011090607; Citation No. CI 2009 43894, OAH No. 2011090383; and Citation No. CI 2010 47822, OAH No. 2011090603, Respondent's Pharmacist License RPH 43129 and Permit No. PHY 49001, were surrendered and accepted by the Board. Pursuant to the Order Respondent was ordered to pay the agent its costs of investigation and enforcement in the amount of \$27,443.00 (\$15,560.00 in prosecutorial costs and \$11,883.00 in investigative costs) and \$40,000 payable to the Board as a civil penalty, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(7), prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license. The Order is herein attached as Exhibit A.
