## Board Actions at July 24-25 Meeting

The California State Board of Pharmacy met July 24-25, 2019, in Anaheim. The board took the following actions:

- Announced the resignation of President Victor Law. New officer elections will be held at the next board meeting, which is scheduled for Sept. 13, 2019.
- Agreed to remove addresses of record for all individual licensees from the board's website.
- Voted to sponsor legislation specifying that citations are not disciplinary actions.
- Voted to begin rulemaking to add California Code of Regulations (CCR) Article 4.5 regarding pharmaceutical compounding of nonsterile preparations.
- Approved a list of frequently asked questions and answers related to automated drug dispensing systems (ADDS). The FAQs will be posted soon on the board's website.
- Voted to begin rulemaking to add California Code of Regulations section 1714.3 regarding community pharmacy staffing.

The board also voted positions on the following legislation:

- <u>AB 387</u>: Oppose unless amended.
- <u>AB 528</u>: Support.
- <u>AB 1076</u>: Oppose.
- <u>AB 1131</u>: No change (support).
- <u>SB 159</u>: No change (support).
- <u>SB 601</u>: No change (support).
- <u>SB 650</u>: Oppose unless amended.
